DUES ARE DUE

We hope that you see it the way we do --- Homeowner Association dues are necessary to ensure that we can maintain the value of our homes.

When we purchased our homes, we signed a contract that obligated membership in our community's homeowners' association (HOA). This requires an annual fee for the upkeep of common areas and the buildings upon them. The Commonwealth Civic Association, our HOA, has two pools and four tennis courts, as well as a Clubhouse that we must maintain. In addition we have acres of greenbelts and public areas to weed, fertilize, beautify and mow.

Furthermore, we host several community-wide events to bring our residents together and foster a feeling of community.

When signing those papers, we also agreed to particular deed restrictions regarding preservation and upkeep of our personal property. Unfortunately, annually, there are a few homeowners that, for any number of reasons, do not fulfill their obligations, thus forcing the HOA to incur legal fees during the enforcement process.

This is where your annual fees are directed. In the future you will see our Civic Association move forward with plans to upgrade and modify those things that help us receive a good financial return on our investments.

We are successful due to the fact that we have been fortunate enough to have people on our board and on our committees who work hard, on a volunteer basis, to make this a premier community in Fort Bend County and a strong, responsive Management Company.

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

Please take a few moments to inspect and evaluation the condition of your fencing. Homeowners are responsible for the repair and maintenance of these fences.

You will find the restrictions on our website, www. commonwealthcivic.com under the Guidelines and Forms tab.

Be sure you comply with the deed restrictions and submit application to the Modifications Committee for review "BEFORE" all work has started.
