

2017 POOL SEASON

Pool tags will be issued to any homeowner that is in good standing with the Association. To obtain pool tags, go to www.crest-management.com and complete the pool registration form on the home page. Pool tags will be mailed to residents upon receipt and verification of the request form. Registration and pick up of pool tags in person at Crest Management's office will incur a \$20 Charge.

Pool tags will be checked by management personnel when entering the pool facility. If a tag is not in the resident's possession or cannot be verified, residents and/or others may be asked to leave the facilities. Only residents with a valid pool tag will be allowed into the pool (with exception of prearranged pool parties through the pool company). Each pool tag allows 2 guests.

When residents pay Civic Association dues, they, rightfully, have certain expectations. Other than expecting the HOA to enforce deed restriction violations (see page 6), our residents want to be assured that the Association will do their part in maintaining and repairing our assets.

Not only does this augment the community's grounds and facilities, it also helps keep our home values high. As new neighborhoods are built in the area, more and more amenities are offered. It is in the best interest of our homeowners that we remain competitive, without taking on debt.

To that end, our Board of Directors, last year, created a Neighborhood Enhancement/Improvement Committee, ably led by Zach Weimer, to make recommendations as to which changes need to be made and to aid in prioritizing them.

On the list this year is resurfacing the Knightsbridge pool. Resurfacing was planned for this spring, however, the Board is now considering postponing until fall as they obtain pricing on other modifications/enhancements to the pool.


They very much want resident input. A decision must be made SOON. Summer is coming!

You can learn more about the options by attending an upcoming Committee meeting.

Some of the other improvements being considered are:

- enhancement options for the large lake at the back of the neighborhood, near the Briarwood pool and tennis courts. Ideally, an area for photo ops (i.e. graduations, weddings, etc.) so that residents have an area they can use for professional or personal photo shoots. This might include a sitting area and additional landscaping.
- upgrades to our parks and playgrounds.
- decorative lighting down Commonwealth Blvd.
- the construction of additional bathrooms to serve tennis players/residents walking through the neighborhood/ children on the playground vs modifications to the existing bathrooms that secure the pool from access during the offseason.

Show Me The Money

Most of us purchased our homes in The Commonwealth because the neighborhood is beautifully planned and maintained. (Good schools don't hurt!)

To many, Deed Restrictions are the bane of their existence; to others, they simply help to maintain property values. To a large extent, they are critical to keeping our community attractive to future/prospective home buyers. Whether you love them or hate them, you agreed to uphold the deed restrictions and modifications guidelines when you purchased your home.

As we approach the time of year when many of us are planning to make updates or modifications to our homes and yards, we must be mindful of these guidelines.

Deed Restrictions address and restrict what a homeowner is permitted to change on the outside of the home. From paint color to pool construction and front doors, from fences to window panes, landscape lighting, security cameras and roofing, our deed restrictions outline the parameters of the changes we can make to the exterior of our homes.

The Commonwealth Civic Association contracts with Crest Management to manage the business affairs of the Association (under the oversight of our elected board). The Management Company does a twice monthly drive-by survey of all homes in the community. They send letters of notification to residents with a violation and recommend to the Directors when legal action is required for compliance.

Whether your fence needs repair, you are painting your home or planning to add a pool to the backyard, it will benefit your emotional well being and your pocketbook, to visit the HOA web site (or call Crest) before you begin. The guidelines and the **required forms** can be found on our website and must be submitted to the MDR Committee for approval.

At the time of this writing there are dozens of deed restriction violation letters outstanding with The Commonwealth HOA. The Association will attempt to work with residents facing economic hardship or, who for other justifiable reasons, are unable to immediately resolve the violation. If you receive a letter, please take steps to remedy the problem as soon as possible.

Contact Crest and let them know when your issue will be resolved. They will try to work with you. Doing so will not only keep you from having to deal with a stressful situation, it will save the HOA money (which DOES affect your homeowners dues, costing not only you, but also the rest of the community additional money).

Production of each violation letter costs the Association \$\$\$. Not only is there a cost for stationery and postage, we must also pay our management company to create the letters. Once the time limit for addressing the problem has passed, it is possible that the Association will be forced to engage an attorney to pursue the matter with the resident.

If the process proceeds to this stage, it becomes an expense for the homeowner from two different pockets - the annual HOA dues we pay and the personal bills from your own attorney. Save yourself time, money and grief - submit your application and any required paperwork BEFORE you begin your project.

REMINDER -- Please put trash cans (and recycling bins) at the curb ONLY on the mornings of trash pick up days. This also applies to lawn debris. If your landscape company habitually leaves grass and tree cuttings in front of your home each week, ask them to start taking it with them. They should be happy to accommodate you. The HOA will pursue this offense - it does frustrate your neighbors.
