

Recent storms wrought havoc on the Houston area. If your property suffered any damage, please remember that in many cases, you must get HOA approval before making those repairs.

Please read through our deed restrictions **BEFORE** undertaking repair/replace. This will include new fencing, new roofing or even painting the house the same color it was previously (and more). Application forms may be found at: www.crest-management.com. Please be sure to include all documents requested in the grey box.

The HOA Board did NOT write these regulations, they were handed them by the developers of our neighborhood. Throughout the years, the Modifications Committee has periodically updated the ACC Guidelines (Architectural Control & Conditions) with reference back to the Declarations of Covenants, Conditions and Requirements created by Commonwealth's original developer. The Board is charged by the CC&Rs with enforcing the ACC Guidelines. The CC&Rs also specified that a Modifications Committee will maintain the ACC Guidelines and make decisions regarding compliance.

These guidelines truly impact our home values and help make Commonwealth a desirable place in which to live.

The Board is Asking For Resident Input

Deed restrictions are a necessary evil and they definitely add to the value of our homes. Responsibility for their enforcement falls to our Board of Directors. In our community, the board has handed the responsibility of reporting infractions to our management company, Crest Management. Crest makes regular "drive throughs" in our neighborhoods, reports all failures to comply, and follow up with a homeowner letter to notify you that you are out of compliance.

We also have a Modifications and Deed Restrictions Committee to review all homeowner applications for changes to the outside of our homes. They verify that the changes we wish to make meet the requirements. They notify applicants as quickly as they are able. They also work with homeowners when the application is denied. These dedicated volunteers spend many hours helping our board maintain home values.

Sumita Ghosh is the board member taking on the Landscape needs of our community.
