

# Sugar Land 2018 Proposed Tax Rate

A tax rate of \$0.32762 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the City Council of the City of Sugar Land. This rate exceeds the lower of the effective or rollback tax rate, and state law requires that two public hearings be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate.

While the City Manager's filed and recommended FY19 budget can be funded within a flat tax rate of \$0.31762; City Council is considering an increase of one cent for the final phase of the 2013 voter approved park bonds. The increase would support the final \$10.26 million in project funding along with the operating costs of the projects and complete the voter authorization in bonds.

This year's priorities: Investments in public safety - including drainage improvements to protect you and your property, innovations in Fire / EMS service and the design of new facilities critical to keeping you safe, such as a new Emergency Operations Center.

City Council will vote on September 4 to place a tax rate on the September 18th agenda for approval.

## West Nile Virus in Sugar Land

The city of Sugar Land has confirmed the presence of West Nile virus at a mosquito trap located on University Boulevard near the Houston Museum of Natural Science at Sugar Land in the Telfair subdivision.

The mosquitoes were trapped last month and Sugar Land was notified that at least one tested positive for West Nile.

The city has increased mosquito spraying to twice per week citywide and will continue working closely with the Texas Department of State Health Services to trap and test mosquitos for the presence of the West Nile virus. The traps supplement the city's larvicide and mosquito spraying operations.

Humans can contract West Nile virus from a mosquito bite. Infected mosquitoes get the virus from feeding on infected birds. The virus can cause serious illness or death.

Dr. Joe Anzaldua, the City's medical director and health authority, urges residents to take precautions to reduce West Nile exposure.

The hard work of our previous Enhancements Committee led to the excellent upgrades to the Knightsbridge Playground and Pool.

The board is interested in hearing from the residents with regard to maintaining and enriching Commonwealth so that it remains the "Jewel" in Sugar Land's crown.

If you are willing to lend a hand (the heavy lifting is handled by our landscape company and Crest Management) and participate in surveying and submitting input to the board in an advisory capacity, please contact Heather at Crest Management (281-579-0761). If there is enough interest, she will schedule a meeting and the committee can advise the board when they have determined which direction they wish to take our beautification projects.

### **Tree Maintenance Alert**

The numerous mature and healthy trees in The Commonwealth, help give it the park-like ambiance we all appreciate. In addition, well maintained, quality species like oak and pecan, add to the value of our residential property

As an aid in properly managing these assets, homeowners are encouraged to visit a couple of easily accessed and well organized websites, via Google (i.e. "TreesAreGood.com" and "ANSI A-300" (note, Part 1, 2017 Pruning Standards).

The "takeaways" from these websites include the following:

1. Tree pruning should be done during the Winter, when trees are dormant.

2. Avoid removing an excessive amount of living material at any one time.

3. Minimize the size of cuts on living material to better enable the tree to compartmentalize those wounds. Numerous "tree service" contractors have been canvassing our neighborhoods in search of trees to trim, prune, or remove. Before turning your valuable trees over to someone with a truck, trailer, chainsaw and a business card, ask if they are familiar with and follow ANSI A-300, the standards of their industry. If they don't, consider finding a contractor that does, preferably an ISA Certified Arborist. This may cost a little more, but the results are likely to be much better.

# Sugar Land Partners with Waze

Sugar Land's recent partnership with Waze, a Google company, to improve mobility via information sharing is the first collaboration of its kind in the Houston region.

Waze is the world's largest community-based traffic and navigation app. The data-sharing partnership will enhance information already available to drivers through a free, real-time crowdsourced traffic and navigation app.

The partnership will provide Sugar Land traffic engineers with an unprecedented look at real-time road activity, enabling our state-of-the-art Traffic Management Center to harness real-time driver insights to improve congestion and

make better-informed planning decisions.

Established as a two-way data share, Waze will provide Sugar Land's ITS website with real-time, anonymous, Wazegenerated incident and slow-down information directly from the source -- drivers and passengers themselves. In exchange, Sugar Land will provide real-time construction, crash and road-closure data to Waze to return one of the most succinct, thorough views of current road conditions today.
