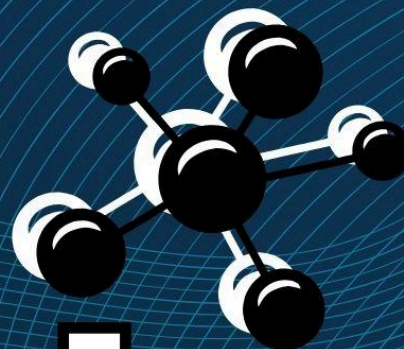


Bio Catalyst

Format

The format of the event will be an open-poster style pitch competition, where pitching teams will present their start-up ideas through a poster presentation. All teams will be within the same venue to allow for members of other teams to listen in and learn from each other. Judges will rotate around between the pitching teams to listen to the pitches. When pitching to Judges, each team will have a 5 minute pitching session followed by a 5 minute question and answer session.

After the opening remarks, participants begin their pitch presentations as judges evaluate each team during the first round. Following this, there will be the final round of pitching. The day will end with a closing ceremony, during which the winners are announced and recognized for their achievements.

The BIDC×BioTec Pitch Competition is an opportunity for students interested or focused in entrepreneurship in the biotech, medtech and healthcare field to showcase and validate their ideas in front of fellow entrepreneurs and professionals. It offers valuable network opportunities, connecting attendees with industry professionals and fellow innovators. The winners of the pitch competition will get a special entry into Desjardin cooperathon. It includes a free 6 week program in Montreal which provides all the support needed for a startup.
