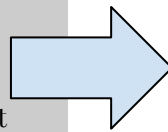

Students in an honors/AP/IB class should expect to learn in a faster paced environment, often requiring them to expand their thinking and understanding of presented topics. At times, learning will extend beyond the classroom and will require additional work/reading outside of class
