- **BIOLOGY** THE FRESHMAN YEAR,
- **CHEMISTRY** SOPHOMORE YEAR, AND
- **PHYSICS** JUNIOR YEAR.

Q: **HOW MANY YEARS OF SCIENCE IS REQUIRED?**

A: ARIZONA REQUIRES ONLY THREE YEARS OF SCIENCE. HOWEVER, UNIVERSITIES AND TECHNICAL COLLEGES LIKE TO SEE FOUR YEARS OF HS SCIENCE AS IT DEVELOPS MATH SKILLS AND UTILIZES PROBLEM-SOLVING.
