Tax Responsibility

Payments made to Chicago Chess Academy are for educational services, programs, or products. It is the responsibility of the payer to consult with a tax professional regarding any potential tax treatment related to these payments.

CCA does not provide tax advice and does not determine eligibility for tax deductions, credits, or reimbursements.

EIN & Tax Documentation

- Chicago Chess Academy’s EIN is confidential business information and is not shared with parents, guardians, or customers.
- We do not issue tax forms (such as 1099s or receipts intended for tax filing purposes) to parents or individual clients.
- Proof of payment or invoices may be provided upon request for personal record-keeping only.

Schools, Districts & Organizations

CCA may provide tax documentation, including EIN information, only to:

- Schools
- School districts
- Libraries
- Government entities
- Approved institutional partners

when required for contracting, vendor registration, or payment processing purposes.

Receipts & Invoices

Parents and guardians may request:

- Payment receipts
- Transaction confirmations
- Invoices for personal records

These documents are not tax forms and should not be treated as such.
