Matching grant to benefit Circle Rocking S Children's Farm

FREE SOIL — Circle Rocking S Children's Farm is accepting donations as part of a 30th anniversary matching grant challenge.

An anonymous donor will match donations up to \$2,000 total that the children's farm receives through Sept. 20. The Circle Rocking S Children's Farm is a 501(c) (3) nonprofit organization that provides touch therapy and recreation free of charge to people of all ages with disabilities. In operation for over 30 years, the farm is located at 5487 Tuttle Road in Free Soil.

On average, the farm serves over 800 people with special needs. It

"depends on donations to provide programs and animal maintenance," according to a news release.
