2025 BBQ COOK-OFF RULES

- 1. YOU MAY ARRIVE ANYTIME FRIDAY MORNING. ALL SPOTS WILL BE ASSIGNED. (PLEASE LET US KNOW IF YOU REQUIRE A SPACE FOR A RV.)
- 2. TEAMS WILL PROVIDE ALL THE EQUIPMENT NEEDED TO COOK IN THE CONTEST.
- ELECTRICITY WILL BE PROVIDED. WATER HYDRANTS ARE AVALIABLE. DEDICATED CIRCUITS ARE NOT AVAILABLE.
- 4. TEAMS ARE REQUIRED TO KEEP THEIR AREA CLEAN AND PICK UP TRASH BEFORE LEAVING.
- 5. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED.
- FIRES CAN BE OF WOOD, WOOD PELLETS OR CHARCOAL. PLEASE DO NOT DUMP CHARCOAL OR WOOD ON GROUND.
- 7. NO FIRES ARE ALLOWED ON THE GROUND, BARREL FIRES ARE OKAY. CHIMNEYS NOT TO BE ON GRASS.
- 8. ALL MEAT MUST BE IN RAW CONDITION, NO MARINADE OR SPICE CAN BE DONE OF ANY KIND UNTIL MEAT HAS BEEN INSPECTED.
- 9. NO PARBOILING OR DEEP FRYING COMPETITION MEATS.
- 10. SAUCE OF ANY KIND MAY BE USED. NO POOLING OF SAUCE OR DIPPING CUPS IN BOXES.
- 11. TURN IN BOXES MUST HAVE AT LEAST 6 PIECES OF MEAT FOR JUDGING, YOU CAN PUT MORE BUT MININUM OF 6 PIECES REQUIRED IN BOX.
- 12. CHICKEN MAY BE WHITE OR DARK MEAT AT LEAST 6 PIECES IN A BOX.

- 13. RIBS MUST BE DONE IN AT LEAST 6 PIECES ALSO. RIBS MUST BE BONE IN. NO COUNTRY STYLE RIBS ALLOWED.
- 14. PORK CAN BE CHOPPED, SLICED, OR PULLED AND AT LEAST ENOUGH FOR 6 SERVINGS TURNED IN.
- 15. DO NOT MARK ANYTHING ON THE BOX THAT WILL BE GIVEN TO YOU FOR TURN IN.
- 16. CONTESTANTS MAY NOT SELL BBQ DURING THE EVENT.
- 17. THIS CONTEST IS RAIN OR SHINE.
- 18. BOXES FOR TURN IN WILL BE FURNISHED.

- You will have the standard turn-in time 5 minutes before and 5 minutes after on each meat. For instance, chicken can be turned in from 11:55am 12:05pm. Once time is up, no more entries will be accepted for the category. Please don't be late!
- Garnish is allowed. Please read carefully on what you can and cannot use. Do not put anything in the turn-in box other than what the rules tell you. Only green leaf lettuce, parsley and kale can be used. Do not dress the box with anything else, not even a toothpick. We will provide a 9x9 styrofoam box.
- A Quick cook's meeting will be held at 5:00pm on Friday Evening followed by wings. We will
 try to have awards ready by 3:00pm on Saturday.
- For any questions please ask at the cook's meeting or contact Perry Pratt 615-584-0004.
- The Deadline for sign-up is **May 31, 2025**. Check, money order, or on-line payment must be turned in by **June 7, 2025**.
- Entry Fee of \$150 covers all three (3) meat categories. \$20 for wing contest. Dessert and Cocktail are Free.

DESSERT (OPTIONAL) FREE ENTRY

- 1. Dessert entries may be prepared off-site BUT cannot be purchased from a store.
- 2. Must prepare enough for six(6) Judges. Portions should be in adequate quantity, BUT not necessarily cut into individual serving sizes (for instance pies and cakes may be presented whole, etc.).
- 3. Garnish rules are waived. ANYTHING GOES. However, any obvious effort to identify the source of the entry will be considered marking and will receive a score of "1".
- 4. You are NOT REQUIRED to present your entry in the standard Styrofoam container; however we are NOT responsible for returning any tray, bowls, decorations, etc.
- 5. Be sure to affix the number on top of the turn-in presentation not underneath. Be sure to affix securely. We are not responsible if it falls off.
- 6. The container cannot be larger than one person can carry.
- 7. 1st place is \$100 and plaque, 2nd place is \$75, and 3rd place is \$50.

COCKTAIL (OPTIONAL) FREE ENTRY

- 1. You must be 21 to participate.
- 2. You may use any alcoholic beverage you choose.
- 3. Cocktails may have no more than 5 ingredients plus garnish(s).
- 4. A blank index card for you to provide the cocktail name and ingredients will be provided. The card is to be turned in at the time of judging.
- 5. A 12.5 ounce glass will be provided for you to turn in to be scored for appearance.
- 6. The team will need to provide a pitcher/pouring container of no more than 32 ounces for cocktail sampling by the judges.
- 7. Please provide a tray to turn this in on. The presentation tray will not be considered in the judging process. The drink presentation tray must be easily carried by one person.
- 8. 1st place is \$100 and plaque, 2nd place is \$75, and 3rd place is \$50.

WINGS CONTEST ON FRIDAY NIGHT 2 CATEGORIES COOK TEAMS AND LOCAL CONTESTANTS

- 1. Benefiting a local charity.
- 2. \$20 Entry Fee.
- 3. Fifteen (15) lbs of wings will be provided.
- 4. Turn-in at 6:45pm Friday night.
- 5. The wings will be judged by the public and team in each category with the most money in their jar will receive a plaque and \$100.
