- Supports eligibility for grants, awards, and recognition.
- Ensures faithfulness to the EFF mission of preventing college dropouts.




FALL

Fall Semester Compliance Due: December 15

LATE OR INCOMPLETE SUBMISSIONS MAY LEAD TO PROBATION, DEACTIVATION, OR A CEASE AND DESIST (CND) LETTER.

SPRING

Spring Semester Compliance Due: May 8









REQUIRED ACTIVITIES CHECKLIST

HOW TO DOCUMENT THROUGHOUT THE SEMESTER




Do not wait until the last minute to gather documentation!





- Take pictures at every event.
- Save flyers and create simple event recaps.



- Use sign-in sheets or QR codes to track attendance.
- Screenshot all social media posts related to events.



- Track fundraising activities immediately.
- Keep everything organized in a digital folder.



Ask questions if you need assitance!

- Schedule a special
 Executive Board meeting
 before the deadline.
- Review events, flyers, attendance, finances.
- Assign different sections of the Compliance Form to different officers.
- Advisor should review the full packet before submission.

PROTIP: HOST A COMPLIANCE MEETING

Compliance is a team effort, not just the President's job.







Attach highquality flyers and photos.

Summarize events clearly and concisely.



Double-check all uploads before submitting.

Make sure your Advisor verifies the packet.



Submit before the deadline - not the night of!

- Use the Reflection Section to explain clearly.
- Share how your chapter plans to recover or grow.
- Communication and honesty protect your chapter's future.
