**Membership Recruitment for Collegiate Chapter Guide** 

### **Overview**

Membership recruitment for collegiate chapters of the Esther Funds

Foundation (EFF) is a strategic and spirit-led process. Recruitment may
take place in the **fall or spring semester**, but **never during the summer**unless **explicit permission is granted by EFF National Leadership**.

The recruitment process should **never** exceed **35 days**, including interest
meetings, informational sessions, the Esther's Experience, and the
induction ceremony. Ideally, the process should last **30–35 days**.

### **Before You Begin: National Communication**

- Chapters must submit a Recruitment Request Form before beginning the process. This form is available on the official EFF website, or a link can be requested by emailing info@estherfundsfoundation.org.
- The request should include:
  - Start and end dates
  - All scheduled activities (interest meetings, mixers, Bible study, workshops, etc.)
  - Chapter advisor confirmation

 All recruitment activities must be hosted on campus with the chapter advisor present.

### **Music & Atmosphere**

As a **Christ-centered organization**, all events must reflect our values:

- Acceptable music includes Christian, gospel, and clean secular music.
- Avoid explicit or inappropriate songs or language.

### **Interest & Informational Meetings**

- Informational meetings are optional but highly encouraged.
- Chapters will receive an **EFF History Book** each year to help guide these sessions.

## **Interest Meeting Agenda Suggestions:**

- 1. Welcome + Prayer
- 2. Introduction to EFF (Brief overview)
- 3. Meet the Executive Board
- 4. Mission, Vision, and History of EFF
- 5. Ice Breaker or Small Group Engagement Activity
- 6. How to Join EFF (Esther's Experience Overview)
- 7. Q&A + Closing

Important: Chapter-specific info like monthly dues, chapter expectations, and internal structure should be saved for the membership mixer, not the initial interest meeting.

#### **Membership Oversight & Team Roles**

The following chapter leaders are responsible for overseeing the recruitment process:

- Membership Chair (Leads the process)
- Vice President
- Chapter President
- Treasurer
- Secretary
- Chapter Advisor (must be present at all events)

# How to Join EFF: Membership Requirements

To become a member of the Esther Funds Foundation, applicants must meet the following baseline requirements:

- Maintain a 2.0 GPA or higher
- Be an enrolled student at the chapter's respective institution
- Be in good standing with the university

- Demonstrate a commitment to the mission of preventing college dropouts
- Acknowledge and accept that EFF is a Christ-centered nonprofit ministry
- 1. **Pay the National Membership Fee of \$27** (includes an official EFF t-shirt and wristband) This is located on the website at estherfundsfoundation.org
- 2. Submit the Membership Application Form, including proof of payment
  - This alerts EFF Nationals to ship t-shirts/wristbands to the provided chapter mailing address
- 3. Chapter reviews application and issues an Acceptance Letter, as long as the student meets the baseline EFF and chapter-specific membership requirements

EFF is an inclusive organization. Chapters may create their own **reasonable**, **inclusive** membership criteria but must avoid any form of discrimination.

# The Esther's Experience

This is the official onboarding period and must include:

- Membership Mixer (to welcome the new class)
- **Bible Study** (Christ-centered foundation)
- Fundraiser (Online or in-person, supports the chapter)

# **Additional Required Activities:**

Community Service Event

• Chapter Workshop (e.g., leadership, time management, or mental health)

Prospective members must attend most of the Esther's Experience events to

be inducted.

**Examples of Acceptable Activities:** 

• Group volunteer project

• Campus prayer walk

• Resume or career readiness workshop

• Chapter worship night or praise circle

**Non-Examples (Not Allowed):** 

• Any form of hazing or humiliation

• Events involving alcohol or inappropriate behavior

• Off-campus events without advisor approval

• Excessive physical activity or sleep deprivation

**Induction Ceremony** 

While optional, induction ceremonies are encouraged to celebrate the journey of

new members.

**Ceremony Guidelines:** 

• Duration: **1–2 hours max** 

- Attire:
  - **Women:** Purple dresses (knee-length or longer)
  - o Masculine presenting women can wear purple polos with black slaces.
  - Men: Purple polos with black slacks
- Can include prayer, scripture reading, member pledge, small reception, and presentation of t-shirts/wristbands. Chapter's may pass out tshirts/wristbands at the membership mixer as well.

#### **After Induction**

- Submit an Excel sheet of all inducted members to EFF National
  - o Include: Full name, school email, phone number, classification, major
- Ensure all members are added to the national database and chapter communications

# **Abbreviated Esther's Experience (When Needed)**

Chapters may request an **abbreviated intake process** (still within 30-40 days) with permission, but it must include:

- Membership Mixer
- Bible Study
- Fundraiser

No matter how short the process is, the experience must remain on mission,

Christ-centered, and aligned with EFF's values.

# **Example Chapter Membership Application:**

Below is an example of the application every prospective member must complete and submit to be officially inducted into the Esther Funds Foundation.

#### **SECTION 1: Basic Information**

We just want to get to know you!

- First Name
- Last Name
- School Email Address
- **Current GPA** (must be 2.0 or higher to join)
- Classification (Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, Senior, Graduate, Other)
- Major

# **SECTION 2: Your EFF Journey Begins Here!**

- Why do you want to join the Esther Funds Foundation? (Short paragraph)
- Can you attend our workshops and community service events?
  - Yes

- o Maybe
- Are you ready to help us prevent college dropouts on your campus?
  - Absolutely!
  - Not right now
- What's your story? (Tell us a bit about yourself and how EFF can support you this semester.)

### **SECTION 3: National Membership Fee (MANDATORY)**

To officially join EFF and be inducted into your chapter, all members must pay the **\$27 national fee,** which includes:

- EFF T-Shirt
- EFF Wristband

### **Instructions to Pay:**

- 1. Go to estherfundsfoundation.org and click "Pay National Dues."
- 2. Submit your \$27 payment.
- 3. Include your name and chapter in the payment notes.
- 4. Upload a screenshot of your payment confirmation below.
- T-Shirt Size (XS 5X)

  - o Beanie
- Upload proof of payment for optional items

- **Membership Mixer:** February 10, 2025 6:30 PM
- **Induction Ceremony:** February 28 or March 1, 2025
- Acceptance Letters: Will be emailed the week of February 3, 2025
