SCOPE

This policy and procedure applies to all coaches, assistant coaches, volunteers, players, parents of players, spectators and all affiliated members of GSBA.

POLICY

Greater Sudbury Basketball Association will remain in operation in accordance to the law and guidelines in regards to COVID-19.

Currently, with Ontario's advancement to Stage 3 of reopening the province, GSBA will operate in accordance of such.

This allows for teams to practice in indoor facilities where permits allow. All practice activity must be non-contact. In areas within the province of Ontario that have advanced to Stage 3, the gathering limit has increased to 50 people indoors. This includes 1 (one) parent and/or guardian per athlete but not including staff at the facility).

GSBA will be operating in accordance with the "OBA's Return to Play: Phase 3 Guidelines".


PROCEDURE

Greater Sudbury Basketball:

- 1. GSBA will provide hand sanitizer and/or disinfectant at all entrances and exits of the facility for parents and/or guardians, players, and coaches to use.
- 2. GSBA strongly encourages coaches, assistant coaches, volunteers, parents and/or guardians, spectators and all players to wear a face cover.

Parents and/or Guardians, Spectators:

- 1. Upon Entering the Facility
 - Parents and/or guardians are to arrive to a practice, program session or games no more than 10 minutes prior to start time and must be ready to play prior to arriving at the facility.
 - No more than 1 (one) parent and/or guardian is to be present per child.
 - The parent and/or guardian is required to sign in upon arrival to the facility and are required to provide the following information:
 - Name of parent and/or guardian
 - Name of child
 - Contact information (email, cell phone number or, home phone number)





Coaches, Assistant Coaches, and Volunteers:

- 1. Coaches, assistant coaches, and volunteers who are present and are facilitating a practice, program or game shall complete a daily self-assessment upon every entry to the facility.
- 2. Coaches, assistant coaches, and volunteers are the only personnel who are to place and or use any basketball equipment that may be used for a practice or program.

Players:

- 1. Players who chose to stay and participate in a practice, program or game shall complete a daily self-assessment upon every entry to the facility.
- 2. Players are not to share and/or trade any personal belongings with other players such as but not limited to towels, water bottles, jerseys, etc.
- 3. Players are highly encouraged to minimize the sharing of basketballs where possible and refer to the OBA "Return to Play Guidelines for Phase 3".
- 4. Players may choose to remove their face coverings when playing on the court. Face coverings should be worn off the court at all times.
