## Scholarship Criteria for the Umbarila Family Scholarships

> Justice Award, Devil Dog Military Award, Hispanic Heritage Award and Kellerman Memorial Award. Students must maintain no lower than a 3.2 grade-point average (or equivalent), 3.0 grade-point average (or equivalent)

for the Devil Dog Military Award, and not have an excessive absence record.

Deadline: The application deadline is April 2, 2025. Applications will not be accepted after

the deadline date. Postmarked will be used to determine mailed applications.
