### Housing Options Include:

#### Motels:

#### Camp Lodges & Cabins:

Cabins sleep between 7 and 9 people in single beds but DO NOT have lights or running water.

Dorothy Page has bathrooms and electricity as well as ramp access—we will reserve these rooms for people with special needs.

Diehl Lodge has bathrooms and electricity with 2 bunk beds in each room.

Peck’s Village contains 4 white cabins with one single bed and one bunk bed in each room, as well as 2 “director’s cabins”; bathrooms come by way of newly built bathhouse.

Victory Center contains two large rooms one with 2 bunk beds and 1 single bed and the other with 2 single beds and one bunk bed. Bathrooms are within the building.

Tents: You are welcome to bring a tent to stay in for the weekend.

#### RV’s:

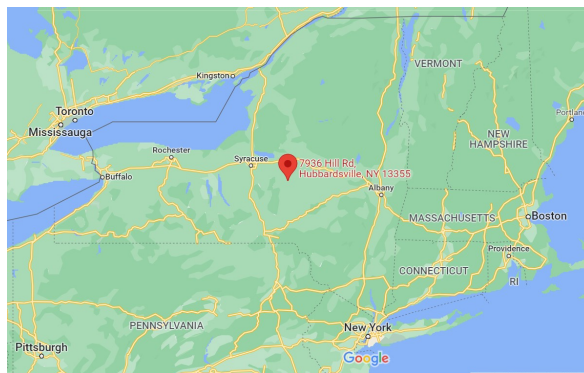
