



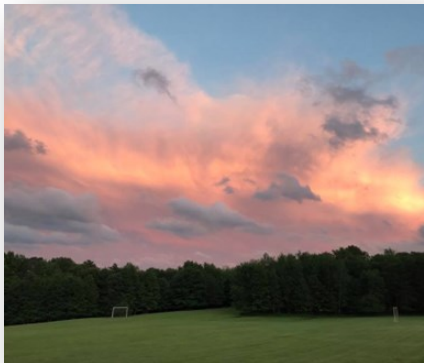

MEDICAL

New York State requires that all campers have a complete immunization record on file. All campers who have not previously registered at Camp Hunt are required to do so. Medical forms are available online to be completed before or during registration.

In addition, no camper may be admitted into the program until permission for emergency medical care has been obtained. All medical expenses will be referred to the parent or guardian for payment. Camp Hunt is not financially responsible for the medical expenses incurred due to accident or illness of any camper.

Note: No medications (prescriptions or over the counter) can be administered at Camp Hunt without a written doctor's order.

WHAT TO BRING

Each Camper Should Bring:

- Bible
- Toiletries (soap, towels, toothbrush, etc.)
- Sleep Necessities (Sleeping Bag, pillow)
- Clothes (2+ pairs of shoes, pants, raincoat, swimsuit, sweater, underwear, plenty of socks, sleepwear)
- Miscellaneous Items (Flashlight, Insect Repellent, Sunscreen)

Do NOT Bring:

- Cell Phones, computers, knives, tobacco, matches, lighters, extra money, or other valuable items.

Note: Camp Hunt is not responsible for broken/stolen items.

DRESS CODE

Campers and staff are expected to wear clothing that is modest and appropriate for camping.

Prohibited: Tank tops, sleeveless shirts, cut-off midriff style shirts, low cut necklines, excessively tight clothing, clothing with inappropriate content.

Shorts: Shorts should be modest.

If any camper or staff member wear a piece of clothing listed above, they will kindly be taken aside and asked to change.
