

Keeping Up with the Pastor:

Happy New Year!

It's a new year and a new decade and that means a lot of new commitments. After the few pounds gained from the holidays, many of us will commit to a new exercise program. Others will decide they need to cut back on sweets and eat healthier in 2020. Have you thought about your spiritual health this new year? Our spiritual health is even more important than our physical health. Jesus spoke about his people in this way: "I came that they may have life and have it abundantly."

Have you thought about refreshing and renewing your relationship with God this year? One of the ways of doing that is to get back into the Bible. It's easier said than done. But it has to be a habit. Last year at this time I was talking a lot about "Faith5" – daily time with the family to talk about God and life. I wonder how many of you are still practicing "Faith5"? The important thing is that we allow God time in our lives to talk to us, to shape us, to bless us with his Word. Maybe you use a daily devotional like "Our Daily Bread" (available free at the church) or "Portals of Prayer" or something else. That is fantastic because it motivates you to read a portion every day either alone or with your spouse.

Today, in our computer age, many are using apps to help keep on track spiritually. "Journey" is a fantastic way to do that. It helps you both read and listen to the Bible every day as well as journal your thoughts back to God. (www.journeyeveryday.com/) By spending just 20 minutes a day you will go through the Bible in 18 months. Maybe you could even listen while you're driving to work every day. What better way to start your day? Regardless of what works for you, the important thing is to just dig in and let God work in your life. The Lord has so much to tell you and so many ways he wants to bless you.

We also have ways that we grow together as a family. Just studying the Word on your own only goes so far but doing it with other believers really helps open our eyes to new things. Are you involved in at least one Bible study with others? Why not? Would you consider joining the men on Monday nights this year as they get together at Chili Corners? Or how about joining the women at church on those same Mondays? Or rediscover the Women of Grace Bible study on the second Tuesday of the month! Have you thought about giving the adult Sunday School class a chance again? Carve out time to grow. Whatever it is, you will be blessed to find a group of people you can meet with and grow with.

I pray that both you and I grow in our faith this coming year, that whatever unexpected events we cling to the Lord and his strength. May he give us his wisdom and guidance through the year ahead!
