Combat Tracking Level-I course is our Basic Combat Tracking course, and a prerequisite for enrollment in to Combat Tracking Level-II and III. This was developed By David Scott-Donelson for Military / Police / Security and Corrections Personnel operating in non-permissive environments, to include Command Staff and Divisional leaders who require a basic understanding of tactical tracking and its operational capabilities.

Our courses cover the basics of tactical tracking, locating, and identifying spoor, following a track line, and tactical tracking operations.
