

**PROCLAMATION TO DECLARE
A LOCAL EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, due to the outbreak of Covid-19, the Town of Lawrenceville is facing conditions of extreme peril to the lives, health, and safety of residents, which necessitates the proclamation of the existence of an emergency; and,

WHEREAS, Section 44-146.21 of the Code of Virginia provides the declaration of a local emergency; and,

WHEREAS, Article 26 of the Charter for the Town of Lawrenceville provides for the emergency proclamation by the Mayor; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Lawrenceville operates under the County of Brunswick approved Emergency Operations Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREFY RESOLVED that the Mayor of the Town of Lawrenceville, Virginia does consent to the declaration of a local emergency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that during the existence of said emergency the powers, functions, duties of the Director of Emergency Services for the County of Brunswick and other Town of Lawrenceville and County officers and employees having emergency responsibilities shall be those prescribed by the Plan and all applicable State and Federal Laws; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this proclamation is effective this date, and shall remain in effect until rescinded by the Town of Lawrenceville as provided by law.
