FERTILIZING: Spread **16 16 16** slow release fertilizer right after snow melts at base of tree in an area the size of the canopy - 1 cup fertilizer to every 2" of trunk size. You can fertilize again in June to encourage more growth. However, it is not recommended to fertilize with **16 16 16** fertilizer past mid July.

WATERING: Prior to watering, peel back wood chips to dirt to assess moisture level.



CLAY CONDITIONS: Require close monitoring of moisture to prevent over-watering and possible drowning of tree. Prior to watering check moisture levels under the wood chips, if needed apply **5 gallons** of water at a time, no more than once a week.

NOTE: Automatic irrigation system can over water newly planted trees. Close monitoring is required.



SANDY CONDITIONS: Sandy soil drains fast and allows for trees to dry out quickly, and requires close monitoring to prevent death.

Watering suggestions are **10 gallons** of water weekly when rain is absent. A good indicator is, if your grass is green, your tree should be fine.

WARRANTY: Our warranty does NOT cover drought or drowning of trees. Close monitoring of moisture levels in soil is extremely important.
