Regular watering is essential to maintain its freshness.</p>
Size Options	<p>Our White Spruce trees come potted at around 3 feet, a manageable height for indoor spaces and easy for replanting.</p>	<p>Fraser Firs are available in various sizes, from 4 to 8 feet, making them suitable for homes with higher ceilings or a need for a larger, more traditional centerpiece.</p>
Pet-Friendliness	<p>The White Spruce has dense, sharp needles that may deter pets from getting too close.
