

CEDAR PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1

Dig the hole the depth of the rootball and a few inches wider around.

CLAY SOIL-keep top of ball above ground 3"-4" SANDY SOIL- keep it flush to top of ball.

STEP 2

Pack sub-soil in bottom of hole before placing tree in hole to prevent tree from settling crooked.

STEP 3

LEAVE BURLAP & ROPE IN PLACE

to prevent disturbing the root ball. Place the cedar in the hole. Rope & Burlap will decompose.

STEP 4

Backfill the remainder of the hole with good top soil. Allow garden hose to soak soil to help in watering tree and settling. Leave a saucer around top to hold water and allow for future settling.

STEP 8

Trim tree of any broken branches.

STEP 7

Add 3" of mulch to top of root ball to help regulate moisture in soil.

STEP 6

Fertilize with 6-24-24 fertilizer at time of installation. Spread fertilizer evenly over the rootball.

16 16 16 slow release fertilizer, can be used in the spring when snow melts and early June.

STEP 5

Soil and mulch **DO NOT** touch the trunk and no higher than the existing top of the ball. Soil touching the trunk can cause the tree to suffer/die.
