



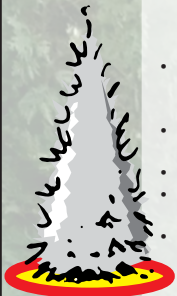

Fertilizing

- Fertilize with 1/2 -2/3 cup of 16-16-16 fertilizer evenly over top of the rootball, preferably on damp ground for 3'.
- 1-1 1/4 cups for 6' cedars. Established cedars may require up to 2-3 cups per tree.
- DO NOT put fertilizer all in one spot, it needs to be spread out.
- Dry soil can burn the roots.
- Ideal time to fertilize is early spring and the first few weeks of June.
- Do not fertilize trees past mid July to allow trees to harden off for winter.



Mulch

- 3-4 in evenly under hedge not against the trunk.
- Prevents moisture evaporation
- Helps with weed control
- Moderates soil temp



Watering

- Water regularly but let it dry slightly before watering again.
- Too much water is worse than not enough.
- Cedars like water but can still drown

Pruning

- Can be pruned anytime but mid summer is ideal
- Prune top of hedge narrower than the bottom to ensure sunlight reaches the whole hedge.
