Reaffirming

As I write this, I'm basking in the afterglow of our Confirmation Dinner. It's so inspiring to see young people stand before the community and share the experience of God in their lives, how they articulate the Christian faith, and their desire to become members of the Body of Christ here at Northbrook. It's also a joy to see the parents gathered to support them, and the Northbrook elders connecting and encouraging them. And, BIG THANKS goes out to Camille Cheairs and friends for preparing and serving such a delicious dinner!

I'm excited to celebrate when they officially become members during worship, and I appreciate that our Presbyterian tradition calls this moment the **reaffirmation of the baptismal vows.** Their parents made the vows on their behalf at their baptisms, when they were too young to make them on their own. I love that we invite confirmands to stand before the congregation and reaffirm the baptismal vows for themselves, embracing the faith journey as their own.

Just as it has been an honor to journey with the confirmands, I've appreciated working with the session as they plan the next steps of Northbrook's journey. We've been talking about it for a while, and we now have a working document - a "two page plan" - that the Session will be finalizing in June. We look forward to presenting it to you and pondering together how we all might support the plan and reaffirm our commitment to Christ's ministry here.

I can't divulge too much of the plan before it is finalized, but there are two exciting things in the works that I want to share:

Northbrook Neighborhood Hangouts - We want to be an anchor in the neighborhood, and we're hoping for some easy - and fun - ways to get to know our neighbors better. Often in nice weather, folks in the community - kids learning to ride bikes, people walking their dogs, moms with strollers, etc. - pass through our parking lot at times when there is no Northbrook activity happening. On Wednesday evenings in June, we're going to put out some chairs, refreshments, and activities (pickleball, anyone?), so that we can relax and enjoy the time together. We're hoping you'll want to spend the evening with us as we connect with our neighbors.

Finding Our Stories in God's Story - Humans are hard-wired for stories. Stories absorb our imaginations and shape meaning in deep ways. Though many of us have our favorite bible stories, we may not really have a sense of the over-arching storyline of God that runs through the bible. In the fall, we'll be starting through a weekly exploration of an abridged bible that reads like a novel called *The Story*. It's not a paraphrase or a re-telling. It's actual portions of the bible, but it removes parts that can bog us down (genealogies or levitical laws, for example) - as well as chapter and verse markers - so we can focus on reading it as a story. I'll be preaching from a chapter each week on Sunday starting in September, and I'm hoping you will consider joining the adventure and finding your story in God's story.


