

Overall Livestock Rules & Regulations				
1	Livestock shows are open to all Missouri State FFA & 4-H members & all Webster County youth & all Webster county adults who reside in the county and pay county property taxes.			
2	Livestock superintendents will do all stalling of livestock, be in charge of the show and shall in case of question, rule on interpretations of the regulations and determine cases not covered by regulations.			
3	Returned entry checks will result in loss of premiums and rejection of future entries.			
4	All livestock checks will be VOID if not cashed within 90 days.			
5	Beef & Sheep must be registered, Dairy cattle must be purebred. Proof of ownership will be required. Transfer papers will not satisfy this requirement.			
6	Not more than 2 premiums will be awarded in any single class to one exhibitor. An animal is eligible to be shown in ONE department only.			
7	Animals must meet all HEALTH REQUIREMENTS set forth by the state of Missouri. The Webster Co Fair Board assumes no responsibility for accidents to animals or the spread of communicable diseases among same.
