


Museum Sketching Sessions: Day 2 Using a grid



We are going to try to draw Laurel & Hardy as Pilgrims. This is a complicated drawing.




Because of the details and need for accuracy since these are people, we will use a grid.







You will need to sketch out your grid and make sure each square is the same size!




You will need to sketch the same size squares over top of the Laurel and Hardy image (if you were doing this at home)




Since we are doing this with a projector, all you need to do is make sure the squares are all the same sizes (1", 2", etc.)




Since we are doing this with a projector, all you need to do is make sure the squares are all the same sizes (1", 2", etc.)



Focus on sketching the basic shapes in Stan's face and Oliver's Face, including the hats!



Now focus on sketching out the rest of their bodies and costumes!




Next: Erase the lines and make the outline of Stan and Babe darker!
