- Welcomes visitors to Harlem, GA, provides community information, fun family-friendly events, and preserves Laurel & Hardy and local Harlem history.

The Annual Oliver Hardy Festival

- Founded in 1989 by cousin of Oliver Hardy, Harlem Mayor "Shug" Lewis.
 - Caters to over 10,000 visitors for one day each year
 - Has over 100 food and craft vendors
 - Entertainment throughout the day
