Decide How You Want to Help

- Consider giving to the Make-a-Wish Foundation, Boys & Girls Club of America, or another organization that <u>supports local youth</u>.
- If you would rather help families with <u>domestic needs</u>, give your time or money to the Salvation Army or Feeding America.
- Or give your time or money to promote the local <u>arts and history scene</u>.

• Check out <u>VolunteerMatch</u>, which connects volunteers with opportunities in their area. You can search for specific causes or keywords to find the perfect match for you.

Connect With People

Another way to impact your community is by meeting new people and developing friendships around healthy activities.

- Join a local <u>exercise group</u> and see if you can help any of its members with the challenges they're facing.
- Identify a problem in your neighborhood and network with people to fix it. For example, if
 the local park needs to be upgraded, perhaps you could <u>convince a contractor</u> to donate
 their time and materials.
- If you want to help immigrants in your community overcome obstacles, find a freelance immigration attorney through an <u>online job board</u>.

Go Big With a Business

If you have an entrepreneurial spirit and want to help others, starting a non-profit organization can fill your life with purpose.

- Draft a mission statement and business plan to tell people your <u>primary goals</u> and guide your non-profit to success.
- Find out if your state allows non-profits to form a limited liability company and work with a formation service if it's an option. Search "LLC Georgia" to kickstart your research!
- Surround yourself with a <u>dedicated team</u>, a trustworthy board of directors, and other people who believe in your cause.
