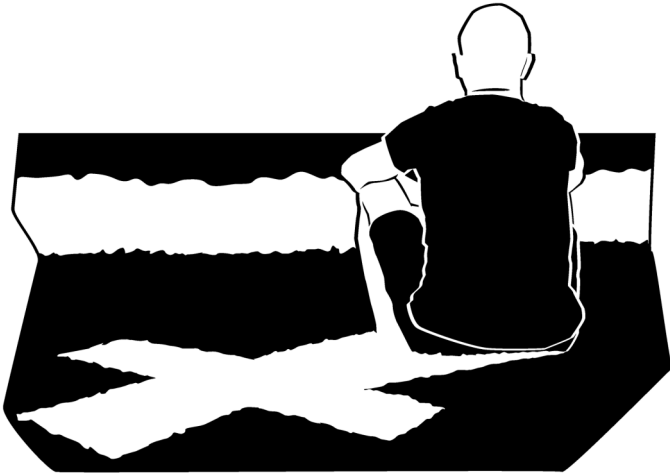

The **Organ in the Choir Loft** has added a singular addition to its many unique liturgical sounds. A **ZIMBELSTERN** has been built by New Century Products in Santa Barbara, California especially for our use. The Zimbelstern is a musical instrument that rings small bells at random as an accompaniment to organ music or for use in the Divine Service. The Zimbelstern (also spelled Cymbelstern) was common in northern Europe, Germany in particular, throughout the 16th, 17th, and 18th centuries. It is rung, during non-penitential seasons, while speaking or singing the Gloria Patri and is of especial use in hymn verses that invoke an upbeat and bright outlook. 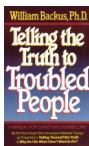
