Donations Welcome for New Server



Dear Members of Good Shepherd,

The Church/School are in dire need of a new server and a new video card for the computer in the Fellowship Hall.

The current server is near the end of it's life cycle and must be rebooted numerous times during the week. The software currently being utilized is also near the end of it's life cycle and will no longer be supported by Microsoft.

The video card in the computer in the Fellowship Hall is not communicating properly with the projector; thus not allowing us to project information on the screen for Bible Study and meetings. Our IT specialist has recommended that it be replaced.

The Council has explored several options for upgrading our system and learned that a new server is the best solution at this time. We have worked with our IT specialist and received a proposal to purchase a new server and upgrade the software to the current version, plus replace the video card in the computer in the Fellowship Hall. The cost will be between \$4,500 and \$5,000.

The Council has approved funding for the project and the Voters' Assembly on July 26, 2020 requested we seek donations for this need.

Your donation will ensure the Church and School can continue to operate without interruptions.

We hope that you will please prayerfully consider making a donation for this project.
