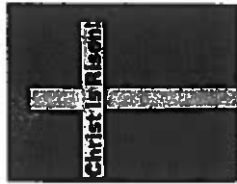


Witness with an Easter Cross ---

Many of you received an Easter Cross to place in your yard last year or before to use as a witness of Christ's Resurrection. This year we plan to have these available on Ash Wednesday again to begin the Lenten Season. We ask that you display them in your yard beginning Ash Wednesday with the plain(white) side towards the curb.



Then, Easter morning, turn the cross around and display the "Christ is Risen" side to the curb. Consider displaying it for the 40 Days of Easter.

Many of you received your cross last year. Please find it in your garage or where you stored it, dust it off and get it prepared to place in your yard on Ash Wednesday, February 17, 2021.

If you did not receive a cross last year or need a replacement, please complete the form below so we can get one to you this year.

This has been a project of the Grundmann Family in preparing, sawing, painting, screwing together, and placing the vinyl letters on to make them complete. We are blessed for their services in this manner. The crosses are provided at no charge.

We will also be sharing this project with our school/CDC families so they too can witness for Jesus with the crosses in their yard.
