**LEARN BY HEART: The First Petition: Hallowed be Thy name.** *What does this mean?* God's name is certainly holy in itself, but we pray in this petition that it may be kept holy among us also.

*How is God's name kept holy?* God's name is kept holy when the Word of God is taught in its truth and purity, and we, as the children of God, also lead holy lives according to it. Help us to do this, dear Father in heaven! But anyone who teaches or lives contrary to God's Word profanes the name of God among us. Protect us from this, heavenly Father!

### LECTIONARY SUMMARY

Ezekiel 34:11–24; 1 Timothy 1:(5–11) 12–17; Luke 15:1–10

#### *Jesus Christ Is the Great Shepherd of His Sheep*

*“The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners”* (1 Timothy 1:15). As He had mercy on Paul, in order to *“display His perfect patience”* (1 Timothy 1:16), so also does He seek out His sheep *“from all places where they have been scattered on a day of clouds and thick darkness”* (Ezekiel 34:12). To deliver His flock, He *“will seek the lost, ... bring back the strayed, ... bind up the injured, and ... strengthen the weak”* (Ezekiel 34:16), and *“they shall no longer be a prey”* (Ezekiel 34:22). He sets over them one great Good Shepherd, the Son of David, who *“shall feed them and be their shepherd”* (Ezekiel 34:23). For Christ Jesus is the one

man who, “*having a hundred sheep, if he has lost one of them,*” would “*leave the ninety-nine in the open country, and go after the one that is lost, until he finds it*” (Luke 15:4). When He finds the lost one and brings it home rejoicing, “*the angels of God*” and all the company of heaven rejoice with Him, with great joy (Luke 15:7, 10).
