From The Pastor

The first issue that naturally comes to mind to many Christians when hearing the phrase “Choose life!” is that of abortion, which chooses death, not life. And indeed, never should our witness to God’s gift of life be silenced! Beyond that, however, are all the other choices we make in our struggles between God’s good and gracious will for all and the universal disability of sin that constantly attempts to lead us away from God and His call to life. But God’s Word gives us the assurance that because our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ has chosen to take our suffering and death into Himself by His cross, all who are baptized into His saving death are given the power of faith to love God and pursue His ways of life according to His good and gracious Law and Gospel. Blessed is the man whose “delight is in the law of the LORD” (Psalm 1:2).

In the explanation of the Small Catechism, we are taught that the Law of God serves three purposes. First, as a curb, the Law helps to control violent outbursts of sin and keeps order in the world. Second, as a mirror, the Law accuses us and shows us our sin. Third, as a guide, the Law teaches us Christians what we should and should not do to lead a God-pleasing life. Notice that the third use is for “us Christians,” that is, those who have been freed from the Law’s curse by faith in Christ. In that faith we discover God’s love reflected even in His Law. So the Psalm teaches us to pray, “Oh how I love Your law,” and “Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path” (Psalm 119:97, 105). Today we receive that light and love to follow our Lord Jesus, the way, the truth, and the life.

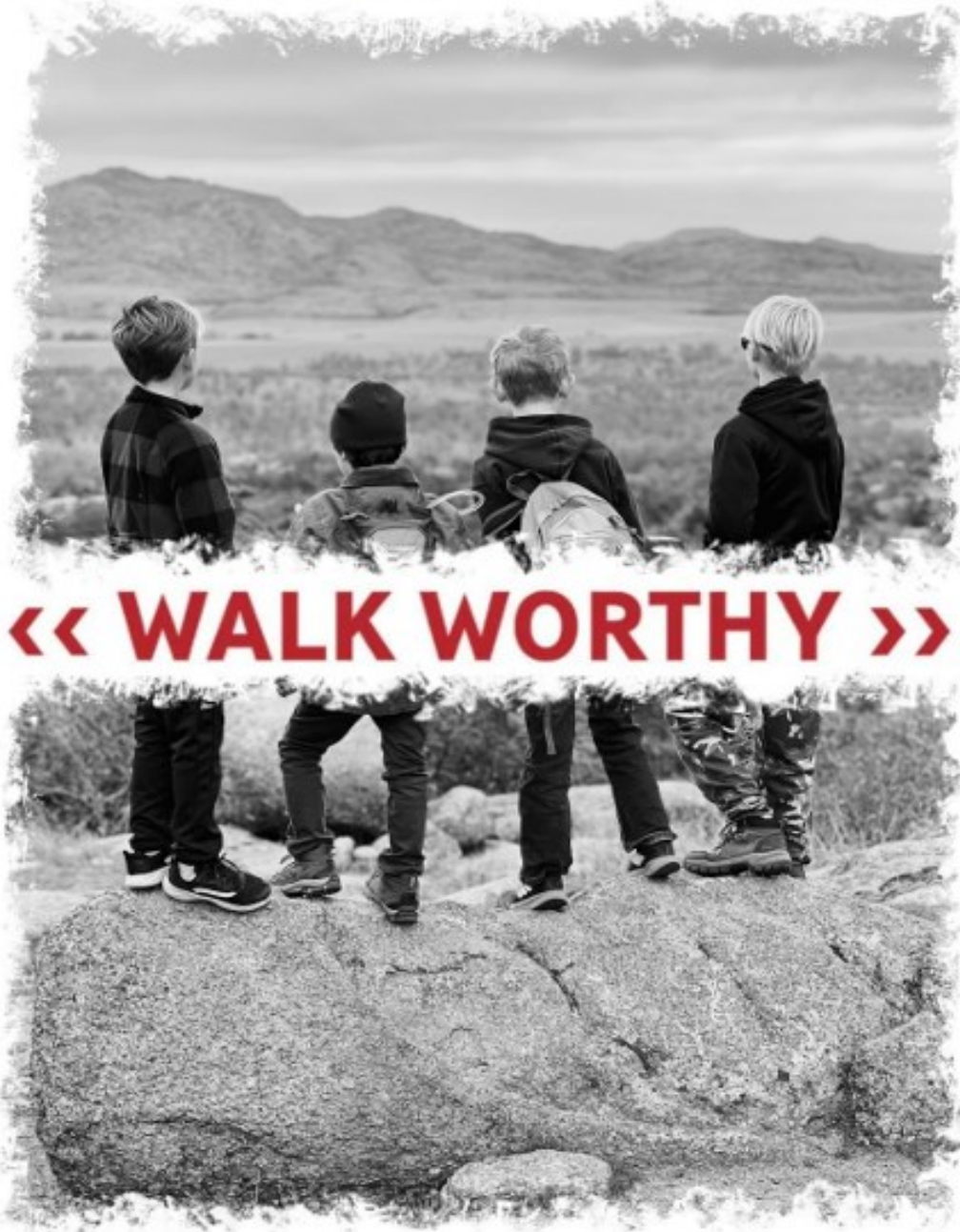

10 Acres Offer Stepping Stone to Christian Future

'Inquiries about starting a church school have come in each August in recent years, he said, many of them from military families stationed at Tinker field.

Christian education was the aim when Good Shepherd church was organized in 1949 in Midwest City high school. Pastor W. H. Hansel, now at Christ Lutheran, 1845 Madison, served the church at first.

After services were moved to Steiger Hall, Roy Karner, a seminary student now serving as a missionary in Hong Kong, worked with the new congregation.

Pastor Groteluschen came in August 1949, from Concordia Seminary, St. Louis.

In March 1950, the church made its first purchase on Air Depot, including the parsonage and half the land now owned.

Later that year, the present church was constructed, being completed in December. In early 1952, the educational building, which includes the Fellowship Hall, had to be added to care for the increase in the Sunday school program.

Sunday school enrollment had boomed to 110 by then. It is now up to 223. Only teenagers and younger are included in the enrollment total.

Attendance in the Sunday school, headed by John Kuschner, 1404 Magnolia, has topped 200- three of the last four Sundays, meaning, absenteeism has been less than 20.

Average age of membership is youthful, the pastor noted, and, in turn, that seems to give the congregation "a great amount of zeal and enthusiasm to really move forward."

"Since most members are together in that they are young and have children," he said, "we are really a church family as well as a family church."

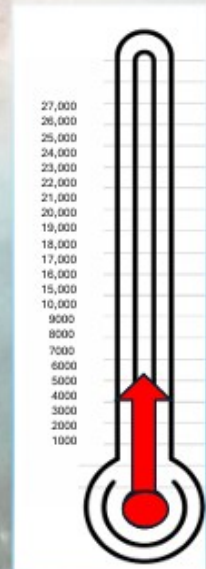

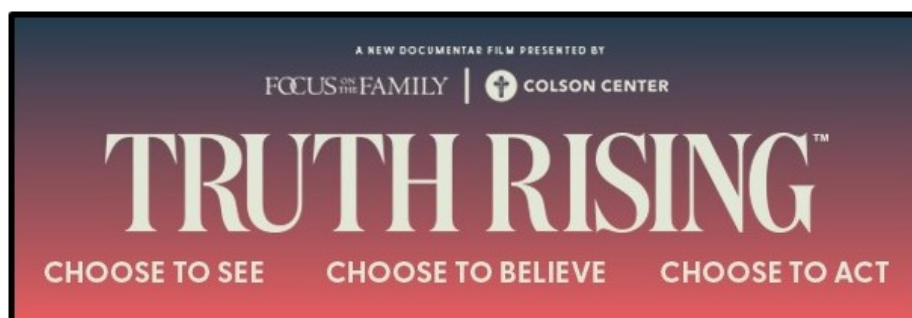

"Prince of Pieces"

Luke 12:49-53 – [Jesus said:] “I came to cast fire on the earth, and would that it were already kindled! I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how great is My distress until it is accomplished! Do you think that I have come to give peace on earth? No, I tell you, but rather division. For from now on in one house there will be five divided, three against two and two against three. They will be divided, father against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against her daughter-in-law and daughter-in-law against mother-in-law.”

It must have been hard on Jesus, knowing that His coming was going to create the worst disunity the world has ever seen. Listen to what He says: “*From now on* in one house there will be five divided, three against two and two against three.” It will be this way till the end of the world, as people hear the Gospel and make up their minds about Jesus—will they believe in Him? Will they even tolerate the people in their family who do believe?

Or will they throw them out and refuse to speak to them, ever again?

Blessed are you if you have a family where everyone trusts in Jesus—because that kind of peace is rare in the world. In my own congregation right now, a man is losing his home because he is a Christian, and his family is throwing him out. Of course the church will care for him—we’ll never let him go on the streets!—but he’s grieving for the family he loves, who refuse to listen to a word about Jesus—and who’s to say that they ever will? We can only pray.

This is the reality Jesus was facing as He walked steadily toward the cross. He knew that His own suffering was just the beginning. Through His own torture, death, and resurrection, Jesus would break the power of evil and give real, everlasting life to everyone who trusts in Him. But those same beloved people will go through suffering just as Jesus did—because, as Jesus tells us,

“A servant is not greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him” (John 13:16b).

And so, even today, Jesus' church is made up of bits and pieces—children of anti-Christian parents, parents whose children have left the faith, spouses sitting alone. We grieve. And yet, it's okay! Because though we may be in pieces, Jesus is building something new out of us—a new unity He calls His body, the church. We may have lost everything we had before Jesus claimed us; Jesus will replace our losses, He says, a hundred times over (see Mark 10:29-30). In His church we discover new people to love and take care of—many of them people we would never have dreamed of noticing before Jesus brought us close to Him. And always we keep praying for those we first loved, that they may finally come to faith through God's good mercy.

WE PRAY: Dear Jesus, You know I'm grieving for [name and name], who do not believe in You. Please bring them to faith. Amen.

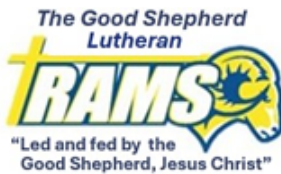

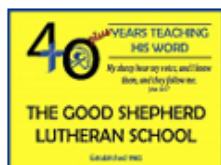
