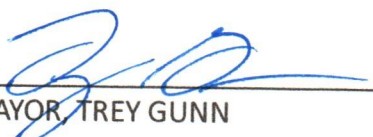

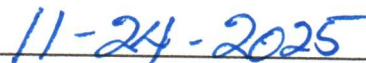
Alderman John Banks voted:	Aye

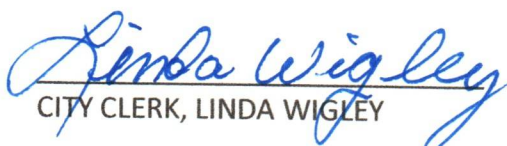
