The Governing Authorities of the city of Florence met in their regularly scheduled meeting set for the 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday in October, October 7, 2025 at 6:30 p.m. at city hall located at 203 College Street in Florence, Mississippi.

Initially present were Mayor Gunn, Aldermen Grantham, Herrin, Martin and Sistrunk. Alderman Banks was absent.

Mayor Gunn called the Meeting to order and announced a quorum.

Alderman Grantham gave the invocation.
