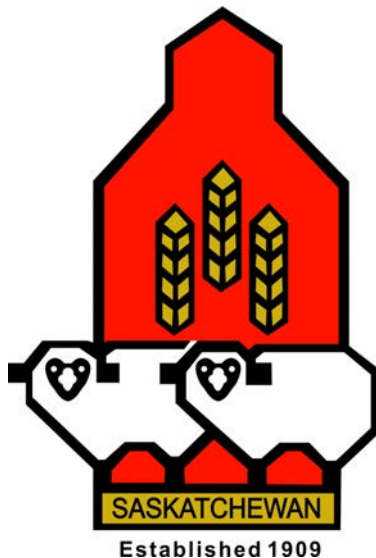

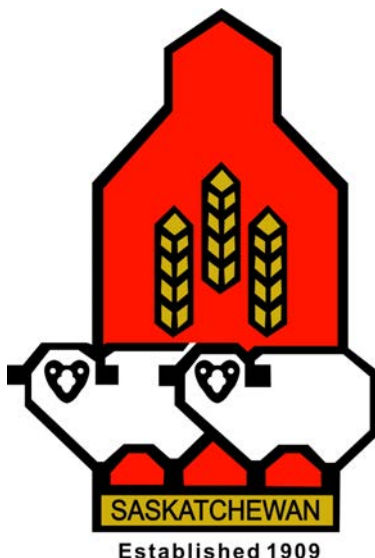
WELCOME TO #GRASSLANDS2022 FROM THE SSBA
