Booking arrangements

- Group tours consist of a minimum of 15 visitors. Children aged 5 - 16 years will be charged half price so long as the minimum number of 15 full paying group members has been met.
- Group tours are not confirmed until your group has had a confirmation letter/email from us.
- The group leader (of groups 21+ in number) and coach driver have free admission.
- Morning visits are 10.30am - 1pm and afternoon visits at 1.30pm - 4pm.
- Discount or membership cards cannot be used against group bookings.
- We welcome assistance dogs, but other dogs are not allowed on site.

Payment methods

A provisional booking is held for 2 months. Once we have received your completed booking form, a non-refundable deposit of £55.00 (invoice will be sent via a payment link) will be required to confirm your booking. Once we have received your booking and payment, we will issue you with a confirmation letter and your final invoice which is due 7 days before your group booking.

Access to the Manor and Garden

Please note that the grounds are uneven and paths are gravelled. The interior of the house is small and also uneven with thresholds and steps and the upper floor is only accessed by stairs. There is limited seating. To protect the historic fabric, large bags, rucksacks and stiletto heels are not allowed inside. It is helpful for us to know in advance if any of your party have limited mobility, or other needs that you think it would be useful for us to be aware of.

Parking

There is a car/coach park adjacent to the Manor entrance along with limited blue badge spaces near to the entrance buildings. We ask that coach drivers switch off their engines while waiting.

Prior to your visit

Ten days prior to the visit, please confirm your final numbers. **The number given to us at this stage is the number for admission and catering to be paid for.** Payment is required seven days prior to the visit.

Cancellations made up to 28 days before the tour date will be subject to a charge of £55 (non-refundable deposit).

Cancellations made up to 14 days before the tour date will be subject to a 50% charge of the final invoice.

Cancellations made up to 7 days before the tour date will be subject to a 100% charge of the final invoice.
