Cash Fare Structure- In County

\$3 per one-way trip, \$6 per round trip
• Children 0-5 ride free with paying adult
• Children 6-12 are \$2 per one-way trip, \$4 per round trip
• Seniors ride for a suggested donation (Need to apply for a Reduced Fare ID)
• Monthly passes are available. \$35, discounts available.

Out of county trips \$1 per mile as availability allows. Medicaid, Medicare and MTM payments for medical trips are accepted.
