



WINTER REMINDERS

As the winter season is upon us we want to advise all of our tenants on the best ways to be prepared for the changes in weather.

Tis the Season to Plow – Please make sure your vehicles are moved throughout the day to allow the plows to efficiently clear the snow. Consider parking on the street until the plow goes through. If your vehicle has to be close to the building, please relocate to the cleared portion of the parking lot.

Salting the Sidewalks – We are committed to spreading salt to keep our sidewalks clean and clear of ice. Please use caution as slippery conditions can still exist.

No Smoking – Even though it's cold outside, please remember that there is no smoking in the buildings, doorways, or with the doors open. You must be 15 feet from the building.

Cold Outside/Warm Inside - Your apartment is heated and tightly sealed. Condensation can occur wherever moisture comes in contact with a cold spot, like windows. To eliminate this, you can take the following steps:

1 - Run Ceiling and Bathroom Fans – Even when not occupied, consider running your ceiling and bathroom fans to keep air circulating. By controlling airflow, you control moisture.

2 - Keep Blinds Open – To avoid condensation on windows, keep blinds open during the day, and do not hang blankets or towels over the windows.

3 - Moisture on Windows – If you experience moisture/water on your windows, please wipe them down daily.
