- December 10, 2021 - Last date for receipt of Letters of Intent
- January 7, 2022 – Notification of Eligibility/Ineligibility to individuals. Upon notification of eligibility, candidates are cleared to campaign.
- Letters received by the Nominating Committee Chair after December 10 will not be considered
