Raven has been with her current foster family since the beginning of January 2019. As she approaches her one-year anniversary of joining the ARC family, we would like to provide an update.

RAVEN UPDATE

For those of you not familiar with her story, Raven is a rottie/lab mix who was injured at 5 weeks of age. She was left paralyzed in her hind end and is unable to walk. She is incontinent of bowel and bladder requiring her to wear diapers. Raven was surrendered to ARC right after Christmas 2018 and at that time weighed 27 lbs. and had multiple open sores from "scooting" on the floor. She had been with a family for 3 months that loved her dearly but came to the sad realization that they were unable to meet her needs.

NORRY CATS

In August, ARC was contacted about a large cat colony that had taken over a woman's farm in Northumberland. The owner, an animal lover, had at first welcomed the cats and kittens dropped off at her barn. She fed them, provided them with a warm place to sleep and paid out of her own pocket to have them sterilized and vaccinated. Unfortunately, people realized she was caring for these unwanted cats and began dropping off more and more, to the point that she couldn't keep up with the endless wave of cats and kittens!

A neighbor began helping her trap and sterilize, but soon realized they needed professional help.

Two ARC staff members, Missy and Kate, agreed to help. Many of the cats and kittens were suffering from upper respiratory infections, eye infections and skin issues from fleas. In minutes, they had nine cats and kittens (including a pregnant mother!) loaded into the back of their car.

Missy, our cat coordinator, took the pregnant mom and five kittens. Kate took the three kittens with the worst eye infections. Once home, Missy and Kate bathed all them, applied flea and tick treatment and treated their eyes with medicated drops. When all was said and done at the vet, two kittens were able to be treated for their illnesses with no lasting effects, five would be missing or have vision impairment in at least one eye and the last, later named "Columbia" was completely blind!

Now that the "Norry Cats", as they came to be known, were vetted and had a plan to return to full health, they were placed for adoption. The pregnant mother, now named "Hart" delivered five kittens while in foster with Missy. Sadly, they all passed away, likely due to mom's poor health and young age. Momma Hart was spayed and quickly adopted. Columbia was adopted with another ARC alumni, Poppy, and is living her best life with her sister and parents! Though completely blind, she's mastered the cat tree, loves playing with toys and keeps her parents up at night playing with her sister! The rest of the Norry Cats were also adopted into loving homes where they are kept indoors and enjoy the life of a spoiled house cat.

This spring, Missy and Kate plan to trap whomever escaped them in the fall to make sure the cycle of cats and kittens stops completely. Please consider donating to our Spring "Norry Cats" efforts. If you have feral cats in your community, please consider getting them spayed or neutered through one of the many low-cost spay and neuter clinics available in Columbia and Montour counties.

In the last 11 months Raven has continued to impress everyone she meets with her sweet, and sassy, personality. Her disability definitely does not hold her back! She uses a wheelchair to explore the world around her. She has attended many events with ARC and she loves meeting new friends.

Due to the generosity of others, Raven has been able to go to Cornell University Animal Hospital 2 times to attend intensive week long therapy sessions. She works very hard while there and always comes home stronger than when she arrived. When not at Cornell, Raven receives monthly acupuncture sessions and at home exercises. While she has a lot of involuntary movement in her back legs, she has also increased their functional movement. This allows her to use her back legs to move herself short distances without dragging, to stand for very short periods of time and to occasionally take a few steps. She continues to show us daily that she is a fighter and will let nothing hold her back. When not using her wheelchair she scoots on the uncarpeted floors to get to where she wants to go and she is FAST!

Raven has gained approximately 15 lbs. in 2019 and takes daily medications and supplements to ensure she remains in good health. Because of her paralysis, Raven is unable to completely empty her bladder. She has been battled several bladder infections this year which require antibiotics to resolve. Her open sores are long healed and while all the hair did not grow back we think it just adds to her beauty.

Raven currently lives with her foster mom and dad, 1 cat and 3 dog siblings. She is loved and spoiled in her foster home and she loves every person and animal she meets regardless of their age and size. While Raven has a home with her foster family for as long as needed we want to remind everyone that Raven is available for adoption.

AFTER 19 YEARS, THE ARC YARD SALE HAS FOUND A PERMANENT HOME!



For the past six years, the yard sale was located at the Bloomsburg Fairgrounds. While it was a great space, we were only open during the summer. Setting-up and closing-down required a great deal of volunteers. The new space will eliminate that need and best of all we can be open year-round. The yard sale is our largest

fundraiser. It helps pay for the care of our cats and dogs as well as shelter operating costs. We hope the yard sale will bring in needed revenue during the winter when there are fewer fundraising events.

The yard sale has over 200 tables of merchandise. There is also a dedicated space for seasonal items such as Christmas decorations, finer glassware and ARC merchandise. There is a book room where books can be purchased for only \$3 a bag!

PA Pets has a Low-Cost Spay/Neuter program available to pet owners with limited income in Columbia and Montour counties. Their Feral Program is open to those people who assume responsibility for feral, strays and/or barn cats. The caretaker must provide food and shelter from the elements. After the cats have had surgery, they must be returned to their original area. This program is only limited by the financial status of PA Pets and the availability of the vets.

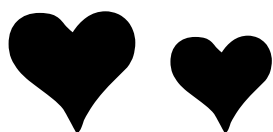

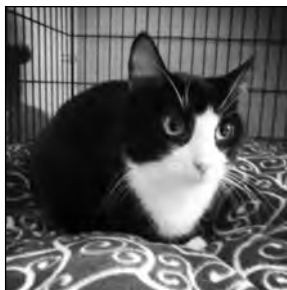



VICTORIA'S LAW, SENATE BILL 44



Victoria was a sweet German Shepherd who was rescued from a Pennsylvania puppy mill after 10 years of breeding. She became completely paralyzed as a result of a genetic, neurological disorder called Degenerative

Myelopathy. She passed this disease down to the estimated 150-200 puppies she produced while at the puppy mill. The bill would prohibit the sale of dogs, cats and rabbits in pet stores unless sourced from shelters and rescues and require advertisers to include license numbers. The bill has strong bipartisan support in the Pennsylvania legislature. Yet, Senate Judiciary Committee has "no plans to consider this bill at this time." Please contact State Senator John Gordner, a member of the Judiciary Committee, and ask him to support Victoria's Law.

The PACT ACT:

The PACT ACT co-sponsored by Pat Toomey was unanimously passed in the Senate. Under the PACT Act, a person can be prosecuted for crushing, burning, drowning, suffocating or impaling animals or sexually exploiting them. Those convicted would face federal felony charges, fines and up to seven years in prison.
