Bobbi was found alone limping along Mifflinville the bridge late one cold February night in 2009. She was only about 2 months old and Xrays showed she had a fractured right leg with 3 They weren't even

sure they could save her leg until surgery. The vet surmised she was either thrown from a car or was hit by one. Luckily the vet was able to pin Bobbi's leg and save it, but she had a long recovery ahead of her.

Sadly, the overwhelmed rescuer did not have the time to devote to them or their future, so they spent 3 years outside in that kennel! Eventually, the shelter dissolved, so ARC agreed to try and change the fate of lost souls, Leo and Louise.

Diane from Bloomsburg then came into Bobbi's life. Diane was a retired schoolteacher who came to the shelter in Summer 2009 to adopt one of our other cats. She heard Bobbi's story and pitied her at the shelter. She took Bobbi into her home as a long-term foster. This gave Bobbi the quiet home she needed and she slowly blossomed under Diane's ARC was happy to have them! They were starving for attencare. She became a loving and affectionate companion of tion and grateful for it! They got walked everyday - sometimes Diane's for 6 years. Sadly, Diane became sick with a terminal twice a day. BILL TO PUT PA PUPPY MILLS OUT OF BUSINESS



A proposed bill in the PA House (House Bill 2601) and the PA Senate (Senate Bill 1154) would outlaw the sale of puppy-mill dogs, cats and rabbits at pet stores in Pennsylvania. The bill would require pet stores to promote adoption by only selling pets that come from animal shelters and rescue organizations. It also would ban the sale of pets at outdoor venues, such as flea markets. Please contact your state senator and state representative and urge them to support this bill.

She knew in her heart Bobbi was meant for her. In May 2018 she made the trip to the shelter and saw the kitten she helped so long ago now all grown up, peering out from her hiding spot. It was official, Bobbi was adopted!

It took a month for Bobbi to even come out of hiding at Stephanie's home. Week by week we would get updates of her progress. After only a few months Bobbi is affectionate, sleeps on Stephanie's bed pillow at night, explores the home, plays with toys and demands her morning soft food. Quite a far cry from that scared kitty back at the shelter. Bobbi knows she's finally (back) home. We at ARC are eternally grateful to Stephanie for rescuing Bobbi not only once, but twice.




