BOBBI RETURNS BACK HOME



Bobbi very happy at her forever home in Harrisburg

Bobbi was found alone limping along the Mifflinville bridge late one cold February night in 2009. She was only about 2 months old and X-rays showed she had a fractured right leg with 3 separate breaks. They weren't even

sure they could save her leg until surgery. The vet surmised she was either thrown from a car or was hit by one. Luckily the vet was able to pin Bobbi's leg and save it, but she had a long recovery ahead of her.

On Stephanie's first day of volunteering at ARC she learned we desperately needed a quiet foster home for Bobbi to recover in after she was discharged. She graciously accepted the challenge sight unseen. Stephanie ended up fostering Bobbi for 3 months until she had to move. Bobbi came back to the shelter, but she did not adjust well and was extremely frightened. We feared she may never get adopted.

Diane from Bloomsburg then came into Bobbi's life. Diane was a retired schoolteacher who came to the shelter in Summer 2009 to adopt one of our other cats. She heard Bobbi's story and pitied her at the shelter. She took Bobbi into her home as a long-term foster. This gave Bobbi the quiet home she needed and she slowly blossomed under Diane's care. She became a loving and affectionate companion of Diane's for 6 years. Sadly, Diane became sick with a terminal illness and after she passed away Bobbi became very stressed and withdrawn. Diane's husband no longer wanted Bobbi so we sadly had to take her back at the shelter again. Bobbi was so sad and afraid and usually hid most of the time at the shelter. We wondered if anyone would ever give this sweet girl another chance.

THE UPS AND DOWNS OF LEO AND LOUISE



Leo and Louise are senior Lab/Boxer mixes who called ARC home this past summer. Leo was a bit timid, but Louise was exuberant, self-entertaining, and outgoing. Shy Leo followed her lead with every step. Although we are not sure what the first 5-6 years of their lives were like, we can only fathom they weren't anything to write home about.

We do know that Leo and Louise have been bounced around like a tennis ball over the last 4 years. The first records we have of them are from a shelter in a Southern state known for its high stray & euthanasia rate. To make matters worse, they entered that shelter with life-threatening heartworms. Luckily, the overcrowded shelter treated them and saved their lives. To save more lives, the shelter looked to transport them to a northern state after they were treated. A local shelter offered to take them, so they were transported to PA. Unfortunately, that shelter took in more than they could handle so Leo and Louise had to live outside in a kennel. Sadly, the overwhelmed rescuer did not have the time to devote to them or their future, so they spent 3 years outside in that kennel! Eventually, the shelter dissolved, so ARC agreed to try and change the fate of lost souls, Leo and Louise.

ARC was happy to have them! They were starving for attention and grateful for it! They got walked everyday - sometimes twice a day. They had people to give them daily belly rubs too! The jolly duo had comfy beds in a double, air-conditioned kennel where they could cuddle together. Louise learned what toys were and enjoyed fetch so much, she would even toss toys over her head and fetch them herself! Although Leo would sometimes chime in, he usually just preferred watching Louise be silly.

BILL TO PUT PA PUPPY MILLS OUT OF BUSINESS



A proposed bill in the PA House (House Bill 2601) and the PA Senate (Senate Bill 1154) would outlaw the sale of puppy-mill dogs, cats and rabbits at pet stores in Pennsylvania. The bill would require pet stores to promote adoption by only selling pets that come from animal shelters and rescue organizations. It also would ban the sale of pets at outdoor venues, such as flea markets. *Please contact your state senator and state representative and urge them to support this bill.*

It took a month for Bobbi to even come out of hiding at Stephanie's home. Week by week we would get updates of her progress. After only a few months Bobbi is affectionate, sleeps on Stephanie's bed pillow at night, explores the home, plays with toys and demands her morning soft food. Quite a far cry from that scared kitty back at the shelter. Bobbi knows she's finally (back) home. We at ARC are eternally grateful to Stephanie for rescuing Bobbi not only once, but twice.

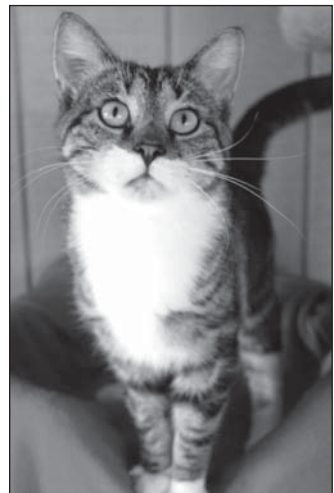
LILLOH is a real stand out with her white coat and large orange fluffy tail. She is approximately one year old. She likes people and gets along with other cats.

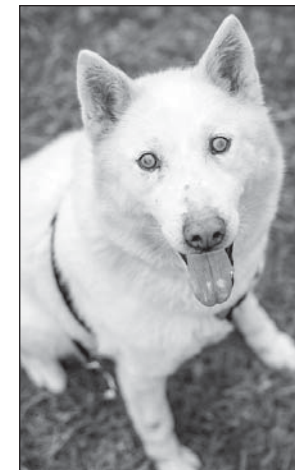
