Even through all this agony, Elsa remains such a sweet girl who is so relaxed and calm with everything that she goes through, says foster mom Sue. Her soulful eyes tell us she's been through a lot.

Each day she is getting closer to full recovery and will soon be ready for adoption to her forever home where she can receive the love she so deserves.

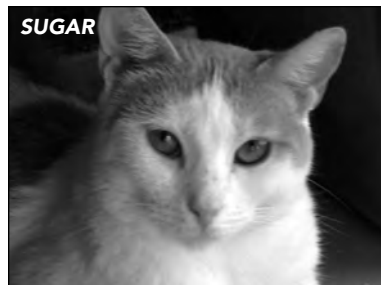
RESCUE A SENIOR!

MICROCHIP REGISTRATION

If you have adopted a microchipped dog or cat from ARC or used a low-cost microchip clinic like those at Tractor Supply, please make sure to register the microchip. Without doing so, a chip is useless! To check if your pet's chip is registered, enter the chip number into this webpage:

www.petmicrochiplookup.org

If the chip was registered it will list the database (like Home Again, Fetch ID, etc.) in the first box. If it was not registered, it will state: "No information found..." in the first box and give the chip manufacturer in the second box. You can then register your chip with the manufacturer.

THE SCRATCHING POST

The Scratching Post (TSP) is part of a popular, growing trend - a sort of coffee house meets cat rescue (though no food or beverages are served). Cat cafes like TSP serve as both a source of relaxation and pleasure for patrons as well as a unique adoption platform for area rescues - in this case, the Animal Resource Center.

The idea to open a cat cafe in small-town Lewisburg started as a bit of a joke. We had been volunteering at Pet Smart and basically begging people to meet the cats. I was also so impressed by the online videos of cat cafes. I was half-kidding when I asked Sarah what she thought about opening a cat café. She had just started a non-profit cat rescue, Cherished Cats Rescue Alliance.

We found the purrfect space in the heart of downtown Lewisburg. We gathered a group of amazing volunteers, our dream team. Michelle and Dianne from ARC completed the dream team by agreeing to be our first rescue. They invested hundreds of hours in to the cafe with logistics, choosing the right residents, and making adoptions happen.

In our first 3 months of opening we've had 40 plus adoptions. Equally as important we've educated a community about the importance of spay/neutering and adoption. We've had an amazing amount of fundraising support which helped to get us started. People have been donating time and supplies; we couldn't be happier with the community response. Recently we were able to pay our rent and expenses and transfer funds to the rescue side of Cherished Cats which will assist with spay/neutering programs.

We want to thank ARC for all their hard work and dedication to the cafe. A huge hats-off to Michelle and Dianne who have been there every step of the way and never give up on our crazy ideas. ARC and TSP have made a difference and we are so happy. We look forward to a wonderful continued working relationship.


