WONDERFUL WORLD Y2&Y5

AUTUMN 1 - SEPTEMBER



This interactive workshop explores creation and caring for our world in a fun, creative way. Students will share what they love about the planet, take part in games and quizzes, and work together to design their own video game focused on saving the Earth. The session encourages curiosity, teamwork, and a sense of responsibility for the world around us.

ANTI-BULLYING Y3

AUTUMN 2 - NOVEMBER



Built around the annual national theme, this workshop engages students with topical videos, scenarios, news stories and relevant Bible content. Year 3 will have the opportunity to explore and discuss ideas around anti-bullying in an interactive and empowering way, helping to bring unity to school life.

CHRISTMAS Y1&Y4

AUTUMN 2 - DECEMBER



This festive workshop explores the very first Christmas. Year 1 will experience the Nativity through the donkey's journey, discovering familiar and lesser-known parts of the story. Year 4 will investigate surprising facts about the first Christmas and then take part in their own journey to see where it leads and who they meet along the way.

BEE YOURSELF Y6

SPRING 1 - FEBRUARY



The workshop will help students explore ways to feel more confident to be themselves and build resilience to cope with challenges and setbacks. As anxiety and loneliness continue to increase in young people's lives, we want to help and equip them to build strong relationships, encourage good communication, and understand their own self-worth.

STORYTELLING Y4

SPRING 1 - MARCH



This workshop develops both RE knowledge and literacy skills. Year 4 will discover the power of a 'blurb', play 'Character Taboo' and explore the Biblical story of The Lost Son, learning that we are all loved and accepted no matter what. In small groups, students will re-create a contemporary version of that story through the art of drama and storytelling.

EASTER Y2&Y5

SPRING 1 - APRIL



This workshop helps students look beyond chocolate eggs to explore the true meaning of Easter. Year 2 will discover the story through puzzles, games and music, while Year 5 will enter an Easter Escape Room to discover what really happened on that first Easter. The question is, can they escape?!

SUMMER 2 - JUNE/JULY



This workshop focuses on the transition from year 6 to high school. Students will have the opportunity to reflect on their primary school experience, share their hopes and worries for high school, play games focusing on friendships and challenges, explore how to be resilient and think about their star qualities!
