



DEEP CREEK LAKE, MD

Located about 20 mins from the campground...If you're looking for a more tourist area, Deep Creek Lake is it. They have a huge lake where you can boat and waterski. There are many arcades, fun zones and minigolf for kids. Deep Creek has many restaurant and bar options, or visit the movie theater or shopping.

The Wisp has snow skiing in the winter and golf, a mountain coaster and other outdoor activities in the summer.

SCENIC RAILROAD


