

We are writing to inform you about the current severe drought conditions affecting our region. As you may have noticed, we have experienced a prolonged period with little to no rainfall, and unfortunately, the forecast indicates no significant precipitation in the near future.

These dry conditions are having a significant impact on landscapes, and you may begin to see signs of stress in your turf and plant material. This can manifest in various ways, including:

- \* Turf: Wilting, browning, thinning, and a general lack of vibrancy.
- \* Plants: Drooping leaves, discoloration, stunted growth, and increased susceptibility to pests and diseases.

Please understand that these visual changes are a direct result of the lack of available water and are largely unavoidable given the current environmental circumstances.

We are closely monitoring the situation and will continue to implement best practices to help mitigate the effects of the drought on your landscape. This may include adjusting watering schedules where possible (if restrictions allow), focusing on deep watering of established plants, and recommending other water-wise strategies.

We understand that the appearance of your landscape is important to you, and we want to assure you that we are committed to its long-term health. Once the drought conditions subside and we receive adequate rainfall, your turf and plants should recover.
