

Free Handicap Garbage & Recycling Service

Need help getting your garbage and recycling containers to the curb? The City of Clermont offers a FREE weekly service for residents with limited mobility.

How It Works

- A written note from your doctor is required.
- Before 7:00 AM on collection day, place your garbage and recycling containers in front of your garage door.
- When the truck arrives, sanitation staff will roll the containers to the curb, empty them, and return them to the garage door.
- Service begins on the next garbage collection day after the doctor's note is received.

What Your Doctor's Note Must Include

- Your name, address and phone number
- A brief statement confirming that you need assistance moving your garbage and recycling containers from the garage door to the curb.

Important: Renewal

The doctor's note is valid for up to 2 years. Before it expires, the city will contact you about renewing the documentation.

If a new note isn't provided within the 30-day notice period, the service will be discontinued.
