• Financial Report – John Huey

Mr. Huey reported on the August financials. The neighborhood is operating at a YTD surplus of \$1,084.68.

- c. Total Expenses (YTD) \$159,507.07

5. COMMITTEES:

• Landscaping (Mr. Leaberry): A detailed landscaping report was posted on the neighborhood website. There's been significant depletion in lawn conditions over the last month. The site Supervisor from DTE was in the community to inspect the property, and there was a soil sample sent to the University of Florida. It was determined there is a type of root rot prevalent in the neighborhood. DTE is committed to repairing the

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damaged lawns with fungicide and weed treatment. The lawns will be treated with heavy nitrogen in the first week of October to encourage top growth. Improvement is expected to take notice mid to late October.

- Architectural (Mr. Leaberry): The neighborhood street signs and posts have been refreshed. New safety signs were installed to increase neighborhood safety. Residents who would like to make any exterior changes should submit an ACC application at the Clubhouse.
- Master Board/Clubhouse Representative (Mr. Hannon): KRCA continued to meet throughout the summer months, minus July. KRCA updates were posted on the website. August 28th was the last KRCA board meeting. The board spoke with the representative from Hoover Pumping System who advised of the irrigation concerns throughout KRCA. The pressure level is dropping due to build up in the ponds. The board approved the purchase of a flow-system to increase irrigation pressure. Utilities were also discussed at the last KRCA meeting. SECO increases are expected to begin October 2024 with another large increase in October 2025. KRCA will host their Garage Sale on Saturday, November 2nd beginning at 8:00 AM. The next meeting is a budget workshop scheduled for September 19, 2024, at 9:00 AM. Residents are welcome to attend.
- Disaster (Mr. Denny): Mr. Denny reminded residents to keep an eye on the Weather Channel since it is the heart of Hurricane season. Stay vigilant.
- Neighborhood Watch (Ms. Bellucci): The neighborhood has nine neighborhood watch Captains. Residents need to complete a contact form and give it to their assigned Captain. Captains will contact the emergency contacts if there is an emergency.
- DAMES (Ms. Larke): The next luncheon will be held at Grace O'Malley's Public House on October 10, 2024, at 11:00 AM. E-mail invites were sent, and flyers were available at the meeting.
