Lake County provides fixed route bus services via [LakeXpress](#).

[Lake County Connection](#) is a shared-ride, door-to-door paratransit service designed for residents and visitors in Lake County, Florida, who have disabilities or transportation disadvantages that prevent them from using fixed-route buses.

Service Hours & Operations

- Standard Hours: Monday through Friday from 6:00 AM to 7:00 PM.
- Saturday Service: Available exclusively for authorized dialysis treatments.
- Out-of-County Medical Trips: Available to destinations like Orlando, Gainesville, Oxford, and Wildwood on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Return trips depart when all passengers finish, no later than 2:00 PM.

Approved Uses

- Medical appointments (including dialysis)
- Nutritional trips, including grocery shopping
- Employment and educational trips
- Other life-sustaining travel

Eligibility & Contact

- Requirements: Applicants must have an ADA-defined disability, be unable to use fixed-route LakeXpress services, or qualify under the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged (TD) guidelines. New users must complete an application process. Those who feel they may need this service can read [eligibility requirements and learn how to apply](#).
